EU Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 – REACH

On June 1st 2007, the EU-Regulation REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals) 1907/2006/EG entered into force. The purpose of this regulation is to ensure high level protection of human health and the environment. This regulation should manage the risks from chemicals and to provide safety information on the substances.

According to the information available to us, our products do not contain any substances which are listed in REACH Annex XVII respectively comply with restrictions provided therein.

REACH requires to inform recipients of articles in accordance to Art. 33, if this article contains a Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) in the term of a Candidate List Substance listed in the Candidate List of Substances provided by ECHA in concentrations of more than 0.1% weight by weight. The Candidate List is updated regularly, usually twice a year. We refer to the latest Version, see: <https://echa.europa.eu/de/candidate-list-table>.

With regard to the Candidate List Substances contained in our products, we are currently in the process of improving and digitizing our material compliance process, which will allow us to precisely allocate the candidate substances to the individual articles in our products at the latest upon completion. Until this process is fully completed, we can provide you with the following information in this context:

Currently, one or more Candidate List Substances are present in different components of our products in concentrations of more than 0.1% weight by weight. These are:

Information concerning SCIP-Database

On the basis of Art. 9 para. 1 i) of the Waste Framework Directive (Directive 2008/98/EC) respectively the national transposition laws, suppliers of articles containing a candidate list substance with more than 0.1% weight by weight are obliged to provide certain information to ECHA. As part of the material compliance process already mentioned above, SMA is currently also in the process of obtaining the information required for this purpose.
